Teaching

After oral and written assessments and discussion with the student, the teacher plans lessons to cover the vocabulary, structures and skills for success at school and in exams.



Younger students often need additional oral practice to help their confidence grow and lessons are as active and stimulating as possible.



Modern textbooks, media, role play, real life situations are an important part of learning. Daily homework consolidates the sons.

Finally, students take a second test and from the results, it is easily possible to see the progress achieved.

All students receive an Attendance Certificate and a report is provided on request.

Family Life

From arrival until departure, students are fully involved in everyday family life — enjoying meals, sharing activities like shopping, watching films, playing games, family hobbies and visiting friends.

Our specialist teaching families for children under 18 offer 24/7 commitment to the student and understand the need to keep their guest entertained.



Whether watching TV, playing games or listening to pop music, everything is in English so the learning process continues throughout the day.



Local Visits

The course fee includes three local visits escorted by the teacher and/or family members. This might be a sporting activity, visit to a place of interest, trip to the cinema or just a mammoth shopping expedition to a local mall.
